Kentucky Power Company’s Update Of West Virginia Proceedings For The Period December
22, 2022-January 2, 2023 and Request to Discontinue Filing 10-Day Updates

Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or the “Company”) provides the following update in conformity with the Orders of the Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”):

There were no documents filed during the reporting period by either Wheeling Power Company or the Public Service Commission of West Virginia in Case No. 21-0810-E-PC.

Kentucky Power further requests to discontinue filing ten-day updates. The updates originated in Case No. 2021-00004.¹ The scope of the ten-day updates was expanded by a subsequent Commission data request in Case No. 2021-0004.² The Commission subsequently directed Kentucky Power to file the Case No. 2021-0004 ten-day updates in this proceeding.³

Case No. 2021-00004 was closed and removed from this Commission’s docket on May 3, 2022.⁴ This Commission also addressed Kentucky Power’s plan regarding its interest in the Mitchell Generating Station, the initial subject matter of the ten-day status reports, by Order dated May 3, 2022 in Case No. 2021-00421.⁵ The period for seeking rehearing or appealing the Commission’s May 4, 2021 Order in Case No. Case No. 2021-00421 expired without any party seeking rehearing or appealing the Order. West Virginia Public Service Commission Case No. 20-1040-E-CN, the remaining subject matter of the ten-day status reports, subsequently was closed by order of the West Virginia commission on July 14, 2022.⁶ There have been no responsive documents to file or information to report as part of these 10-day updates since September 1, 2022.

Kentucky Power Company respectfully submits that the need for ten-day status reports in this case no longer exists with the underlying proceedings having been resolved and removed from the respective commissions’ dockets. The Company thus proposes that this report be its final status report in this proceeding.
