THIS DAY came Arthur Curtis, et al, and filed with McCracken County Court a petition for the establishment of a Water District and the appointment of Water Commissioners for the purpose of furnishing a water supply to the citizens of the West McCracken County Water District described as follows:

Beginning at a stake located 200 feet East of the East line of the Metropolis Lake Road where the said line intersects a point 200 feet North of Shawnee Lane; thence in a Southerly direction along, and with a line parallel with and 200 feet East of the East line of the Metropolis Lake Road a distance of 302.5 feet, more or less, to a point 400 feet North of the Central Road; thence in an Easterly direction along a line parallel with the North line of the Central Road and 200 feet therefrom a distance of 3,100 feet, more or less, to a stake located 200 feet East of the Metropolis Perry Landing Road; thence in a Southerly direction along the line parallel and 200 feet East of the East line of the Metropolis Perry Landing Road 1,450 feet, more or less, to a stake 200 feet South of the Ogden Landing Road; thence in a Westerly direction and along the line parallel with the South line of the Ogden Landing Road and 200 feet East thereof 9,200 feet, more or less, to a point 200 feet West of the Bradford Road; thence in a Southerly direction along and parallel with the East line of the Bradford Road and 200 feet East thereof 15,390 feet, more or less, to a stake 200 feet South of U.S. Highway 300; thence in a Westerly direction parallel with U. The above styled petition coming on for hearing herein
it appearing to the Court that notice of the filing of said
petition in the form directed by this Court was made in the
Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation in McCracken
County, Kentucky, for three successive legal days, and that more
thirty days have elapsed after the publication of said
notice, and no objections having been filed to the establishment
of said district, and the case having been set for further hearing
being submitted to the Court upon the pleadings and exhibits
herein, and the Court being sufficiently advised and it
appearing to the Court that the establishment of said district
is reasonably necessary for the public health, for the protection
and comfort of the residents of the area described in the petition
hereinafter set out, it is ordered and adjudged as follows,
to-wit:

1. That there is hereby established within the territory
described as follows, to-wit:

beginning at a stake located 200 feet East of the East line of the Metropolis Lake Road where the said line intersects a point 200 feet North of Shawnee Lane; thence in a Southerly direction along and with a line parallel with and 200 feet East of the East line of the Metropolis Lake Road a distance of 6025 feet, more or less, to a point 200 feet North of the Arneal Road; thence in an Easterly direction along a line parallel with the North line of the Carneal Road and 200 feet therefrom a distance of 8,100 feet, more or less, to a stake located 200 feet East of the Metropolis Ferry Landing Road; thence in a Southerly direction and along the line parallel and 200 feet East of the East line of the Metropolis Ferry Landing Road 6,450 feet, more or less, to a stake 200 feet South of the Ogden Landing Road; thence in a Westerly direction and along the line parallel with the South line of the Ogden Landing Road and 200 feet South hereof 6,200 feet, more or less, to a point 200 feet East of the Bradford Road; thence in a Southerly direction along and parallel with the East line of the Bradford Road and 200 feet East thereof 15,800 feet, more or less, to a stake 200 feet South of U.S. Highway #60; thence in a Westerly direction parallel with U. S. Highway #60 to the Minkleville road fork and continuing parallel with the South line of the Minkleville Road and in a distance of 200 feet thereof 7,750 feet, more or less, to a stake 200 feet West of the McKendree Church Road; thence in a Northerly direction and parallel with the West line of the McKendree Church Road and 200 feet West thereof 2,450 feet, more or less, to a stake 200 feet South of U.S. Highway #60; thence in a Westerly direction along a line parallel with the South line of U. S. Highway #60 and 200 feet South thereof 10,100 feet, more or less, to a stake 200 feet West of the Rice Springs Road; thence in a Northerly direction and parallel with the West line of the Rice Springs Road and 200 feet West thereof a distance of 7,000 feet, more or less, to a point in the center line of the Woodville Road, the same being a point in the boundary line of the U. S. Reservation - Atomic Energy Commission; thence in an Easterly direction and Northerly direction along and with the meanderings of the boundary line of the U. S.
