## MUNICIPAL ORDER NO. 2489

A MUNICIPAL ORDER APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING PADUCAH WATER WORKS MERGING WITH THE WEST MCCRACKEN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Paducah Water Works, a municipally owned water company, has negotiated and executed a merger agreement with the West McCracken County Water District; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid agreement must be reviewed and approved by the Kentucky Public Service Commission; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to evidence to the Kentucky Public Service Commission that the City of Paducah is both aware of the aforesaid merger and does authorize and approved same.
