Further, discuss each specific PBR component calculation and how it would be incrementally impacted by a shift of Choice volumes to commodity sales volumes if Choice customers no longer purchased their gas from marketers.

- c. Provide calculations for each PBR component showing PBR savings for each of the years indicated (five years ending 2023) if Choice customers had bought their gas from Columbia Kentucky instead of marketers.
- d. Provide total annual throughput on Columbia Kentucky's system for 2018 through 2023, as of this date.
