2	Q:	Please state your name and business address.
4	A:	My name is Monica Sturgill and my business address is 1544 Winchester Avenue, Suite
5	1108	Ashland, KY 41102.
6	Q:	What is your current position and what are your responsibilities?
7	A:	I am currently a contract employee for Natural Gas Services, LLC ("Natural Gas
8	Servic	es"). At this point in time, I am responsible for the data collection, review, and submission
9	of all 1	requirements for filing a tariff with the KY PSC for Natural Gas Services.
LO	Q:	What is your educational background?
l1	A:	I have a Bachelor in Business Administration in Economics and a Master of Business
12	Admir	nistration. I have over 15 years of experience working in the natural gas business.
L3	Q:	What is your employment background?
L4	A:	I worked for Hay Exploration, Inc. since 2008 until 2020. In 2020, I began working as a
15	contra	ct employee for various companies in the energy sector.
L6	Q:	Have you previously testified before the Kentucky Public Service Commission?

L8		II. <u>TESTIMONY</u>

20	Q:	What is the purpose of your testimony in this proceeding?
21	A:	The purpose of my testimony is to support the Natural Gas Services application for new
22	rates.	
23	Q:	Who is Hay Exploration and what is the nature of the relationship between Hay
24		Exploration and Natural Gas Services, LLC?

1	A:	Hay Exploration, Inc. and Natural Gas Services. have a common owner. Hay	
2		Exploration, Inc. operates wells and gathering systems that provide natural gas to Natural	
3		Gas Services.	
4	Q:	Is there or will there be a formal agreement between Hay Exploration and Natural	
5		Gas Services, LLC?	
6	A:	Yes. We are working with our legal team to draft and finalize an agreement between Hay	
7		Exploration and Natural Gas Services. We anticipate that agreement will be executed in	
8		the next two weeks.	
9	Q:	What does the agreement cover?	
10	A:	The agreement will outline the scope of the relationship of Hay Exploration, Inc. and	
11		Natural Gas Services. along with the terms and expectations of the parties' relationship.	
12	Q:	What role, if any, will Hay Exploration play in Natural Gas Services, LLC's	
13		operations?	
14	A:	Hay Exploration, Inc. will provide natural gas via the gathering lines and wells to Natural	
15		Gas Services. At times, Natural Gas Services may contract Hay Exploration for the use of	
16		the equipment and/or labor for any issues that may arise that would be outside of the	
17		scope of normal operation.	
18	Q:	Approximately how many customers does Natural Gas Services, LLC, intend to	
19		serve?	
20	A:	Natural Gas Services intends to serve approximately one hundred and ten (110)	
21	customers.		
22	Q:	Approximately how many customers currently have "free gas" allotments for gas	
23		services?	

- 1 A: There are approximately 32 "free gas" customers and 78 non-free gas customers.
- 2 **O:** How will customers be billed for gas services?
- 3 A: Non-free gas customers will pay a minimum customer charge of \$15 per month and gas
- 4 usage shall be charged at \$6.96 per mcf.
- 5 Q: How was the flat customer charge and the per mcf charge calculated?
- 6 A: The flat customer charge was discussed with KPSC staff and adopted by Natural Gas
- 7 Services during an informal conference on 2-18-22. The per mcf charge calculated was
- 8 based upon the summation of NYMEX Strip (Nov 21-Mar 22) of \$3.63 and the
- 9 Appalachian Differential of -\$0.56 multiplied by the BTU Adjustment of \$1.05 to give an
- estimated price to be received of \$3.22 per mcf. Adding the expense cost outlined in the
- tariff application of \$3.74, the per mcf price to be charge requested by Natural Gas
- Services will be \$6.96.
- 13 Q: Please explain the assumptions made when setting both recurring and non-
- 14 recurring charges.

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- 15 A: Due to the lack of historical data and the acquisition of other company's free gas leases
  16 and farm tap customers, Natural Gas Services is making an assumption that the amount
  17 of farm taps equates to approximately one hundred and ten customers (110). In the past,
  18 the customers have not been monitored or billed. Natural Gas Services is applying for a
- 20 monitoring and billing has not been done in the past, estimates have been calculated for

tariff in order to be able to monitor and bill the usage of gas by its customers. Since

- 21 the amount of occurrences on both recuring and non-recurring charges based on the
- number of customers, our experience with the customers, and my experience in the

- natural gas industry. All dollar amount values have been calculated using fair market
- 2 rates and average hours for labor and equipment.
