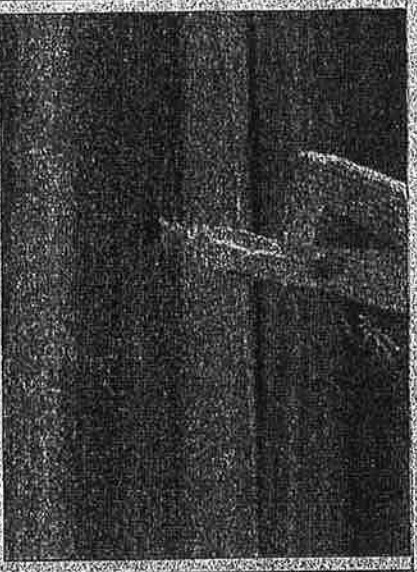

Alternative #1 (no action alternative): If no action is taken to replace and upgrade the pump station, overflows will continue to occur.

Alternative #2: Remove the existing pump station. Construct a new, upgraded pump station at the same location.
