

Also refer to Jonathan Creek District's response to Commission Staff's First Request (filed July 7, 2022), Item 7, JC1_7_-_Nonrecurring_Charges.xlsx. Jonathan Creek District reported Late Penalties of \$9,575. Reconcile and explain the difference.

Response: As noted in a preamble to the District's response to Staff's First Request "...the test year in this case is 2021." Both figures for Late Penalties mentioned in this item are correct; \$2,858 is the amount for 2020 and \$9,575 is the amount for 2021.
