APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 2021-00410 DATED NOV 07 2022

On May 13, 2022, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Jonathan Creek Water District's (Jonathan Creek District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$23,448, an approximate increase of 2.42 percent. On September 23, 2022, Commission Staff determined Jonathan Creek District would require an increase of \$91,529 or 9.46 percent in revenue from water sales. Jonathan Creek District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirements and that Jonathan Creek District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows
