



By Order dated September 27, 2022 in Case No. 2021-00415, the Public Service Commission ("PSC") adjusted Bracken County Water District's rates for water service and directed its rates be increased in two phases. Pursuant to that Order, Bracken District will implement the second phase of the rate increase on September 27, 2023 and will charge the following rates for water service rendered on and after September 27, 2023:

- First 2,000 Gallons \$32.13 Minimum Bill
- Next 38,000 Gallons \$0.01265 Per Gallon
- Over 40,000 Gallons \$0.01004 Per Gallon
- Wholesale \$0.00482 Per Gallon
- Bulk Sales \$0.1150 Per Gallon
- Multiple Users Minimum \$32.07 Per Unit
