

## Request for disbursement of Water Loss Surcharge funds

### Disbursement Request #5

June 18, 2026

Garrison-Quincy-KY-O-Heights (Garrison Water) would like to request the use of Water Loss Surcharge funds in the amount of \$23,897.43 for the replacement of 10 failed valves in our system. This is one of the items that was mentioned in our Infrastructure Improvement Plan at the onset of the Water Loss Surcharge Program.

In 2024 any valve in our system that had any questionable issues were exercised. We used a mechanical valve exerciser to help bring them back to good working order. Kentucky Rural Water brought the equipment with them and assisted in the exercising of these valves. Although it seemed to help some of our valves, many did not recover to full use.

The ten (10) valves that are needing replaced are necessary to be completely closed off in order to be useful in leak detection. Many of these valves will have bypass meters installed around them at a later date to allow the District to monitor the exact usage on certain areas of our system.

The attached quote includes all parts that is necessary for the installation of the ten valves. It includes the valves, gripping gaskets, pipe and secure couplings to fasten back to the existing pipe. This price is current and accurate. Currently, Garrison Quincy KY O Heights Water District has \$36,462.46 in the water loss surcharge account.
