Part-Time Sports Assistant /Night Clerk

Job Summary

Job holder assists in collection of local and area sports news. Job holder collects sports news primary by phone or online, but might also travel to sporting venues to collect information, taking notes on facts, details, scores, and other data vital in presenting an accurate description and account of the event being described in the newspaper. Work shifts can include nights and/or weekends and some holidays, as per assigned by editor. This description is not exhaustive. \$11.00 per hour working 25 hours per week. Monday - Friday nights. 5pm to 10pm.

Major Responsibilities

1. Take phone calls from coaches and other sources who provide details, statistics and other pertinent data regarding sporting events. Collect data from online sources regarding sporting events. Based on the information, compose story or roundup for publication, using newspaper's journalistic style.
2. Attend sports events, cover the event by observing, taking factual, accurate notes and collecting other pertinent information, and compose an account of the event in story form, using newspaper's journalistic style.
3. Assist the sports editor by collecting information for the agate section, composing the information according to the newspaper's style or presentation, using paginating computer system to compile the data for camera-ready processing.
4. Other duties as assigned by sports editor and/or editor.
5. Able to react to changes in productivity and to handle other essential tasks as assigned. Sports assistant/clerk customarily works closely with sports editor and sports reporter. For out-of-office writing assignments, sports assistant is generally not supervised while out of the office.

Job Specifications

Education: High school graduate preferred.
Work experience: Minimum 6 months in similar position.
Skills & abilities: Exceptional knowledge of grammar, punctuation, composition, spelling, sentence structure, ability to write fluently and to produce articles that are informative and understandable even to people of minimal education.
Other job related requirements: Valid driver's license, ability to drive.
Pressure of work: High pressure to produce news/sports material under extreme press of deadline, often in charged atmosphere that includes noise, and peers working in close proximity.

Working Conditions

Job holder sometimes travels outside the newspaper building to site of sports events to be covered, often working evening or other odd hours, sometimes in extreme weather conditions.

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 2021-00423 DATED MAY 11 2022

On November 15, 2021, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Caldwell County Water District's (Caldwell District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$117,094 an approximate increase of 8.79 percent. On March 18, 2022, Commission Staff determined Caldwell District would require an increase of \$215,034 or 16.26 percent in revenue from water sales. Caldwell District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirements and that Caldwell District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:

The proposed rates shall not become effective until the Public Service Commission has issued an Order approving these rates.
 The rates will increase the monthly bill of a typical residential customer using 3,277 gallons a month from \$55.75 to \$64.80 increase of \$9.05, or approximately 16.23 percent.

 If the Commission does not receive any request for intervention or hearing in this matter within 30 days after the date of publication of this customer notice, the Commission will proceed to render a decision in the matter.
