RE: *Application of Kentucky Utilities Company For An Order Authorizing the Issuance of Indebtedness*
Case No. 2022-00008

Dear Ms. Bridwell:

On March 2, 2022, Kentucky Utilities (“KU”) filed an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) in the above-referenced matter requesting, in pertinent part, authority to incur additional debt not to exceed a total of \$550 million in the form of First Mortgage Bonds, Intermediate Term Financing, or a combination of both through December 31, 2023. KU specifically requested authority in its Application to issue such financing in 2022 or 2023.¹

On April 14, 2022, the Commission issued a final Order. The Order references KU’s request to issue the financing in 2022 or 2023.² However, Ordering Paragraph 1 grants the requested financing authority only through December 31, 2022.³

KU believes Ordering Paragraph 1 contains a clerical error and the paragraph should be modified to read as follows: “KU is authorized to issue long-term debt in the form of First Mortgage Bonds, or Intermediate Term Financing, or a combination of both, in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$550 million, from the date that this Order is entered through December 31, 2023.”

KU respectfully requests that the Commission issue a *nunc pro tunc* order, correcting the reference in Ordering Paragraph 1 to “2022” to be “2023.” It is well settled that the Commission

has authority to correct clerical errors in its orders, so long as the mistake is plainly shown in the record.⁴ The record in this case shows the reference to “2022” in Ordering Paragraph 1 is an inadvertent clerical error and the year in Ordering Paragraph 1 should be “2023.”

In accordance with the Commission’s Order of July 22, 2021 in Case No. 2020-00085 (Electronic Emergency Docket Related to the Novel Coronavirus COVID-19), this is to certify that the electronic filing has been transmitted to the Commission on April 22, 2022; and that there are currently no parties in this proceeding that the Commission has excused from participation by electronic means.
