Applicable to firm natural gas service, which is comprised of commodity gas supply and local delivery service, required for all domestic purposes in private residences, single occupancy apartments, and common use areas of multioccupancy buildings, when supplied at one point of delivery where distribution mains are adjacent to the premises to be served.

#### NET MONTHLY BILL

The Net Monthly Bill is determined as follows: All gas is billed in units of 100 cubic feet (CCF).

When not so paid, the Gross Monthly Bill, which is the Net Monthly Bill plus 5%, is due and payable. Customers who receive a pledge for or notice of low income assistance from an authorized agency will not be assessed or required to pay a late payment charge for the current bill for which the pledge or notice is received. An authorized agency is an organization in Kentucky that administers federal Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Programs and/or the Home Energy Assistance Programs offered by Duke Energy Kentucky.

Applicable to firm natural gas service, which is comprised of commodity gas supply and local delivery service, required for any purpose by an individual non-residential customer at one location when supplied at one point of delivery where distribution mains are adjacent to the premises to be served. This schedule is also applicable to non-metered natural gas commodity supplies and local delivery service for street lighting to such entities as certificated homeowners associations, businesses, and federal, state, and local governments. The Company may decline requests for service under this tariff due to gas supply limitations.

# RIDER GCAT

# GAS COST ADJUSTMENT TRANSITION RIDER

### APPLICABILITY

Applicable to all customers served under Rate FT-L after the effective date of this tariff who paid gas supply costs through the Company's Gas Cost Adjustment (GCA) mechanism during the twelve-month period immediately preceding the date on which the customer began receiving service under Rate FT-L.

### **GCA TRANSITION RIDER**

A charge or credit shall be applied to all volumes transported pursuant to Rate FT-L in order to pass through to former GCA customers the Company's quarterly Actual Adjustment (AA), Balance Adjustment (BA), and Supplier Refund and Reconciliation Adjustment (RA) costs or credits during the first twelve months that the former sales customer participates in the Company's firm transportation program.

The amount of this charge or (credit) shall be \$0.00548 per 100 cubic feet. This rate shall be in effect (R) during the month of March 2022 through May 2022 and shall be updated quarterly, concurrent with (T) the Company's GCA filings.
