Salary of Responsible Employees:	<p>Kim Miller, bookkeeper, is a salaried employee, whose salary pro-rates to \$29.61/hour.</p> <p>Larry Wagoner, Meter Reader, is a salaried employee, whose salary pro-rates to \$26.29/hour</p> <p>Site trips require gasoline and put mileage on District vehicles; the year 2019 IRS per-mile reimbursement rate is \$0.58.</p>
Approximate cost of work related to charge:	<p>\$50.88 (\$29.61 + \$13.15 + \$8.12; 1 hour of Larry Wagoner's time, 0.5 hours of Kim Miller's time, and mileage reimbursement at the IRS rate for 14 miles – the equivalent of two round trips from the District's Office to the District's Northern boundary and back, halved to approximate an average trip).</p>
Requested Fee for Tariff:	<u>\$35.00</u>
