### JESSAMINE-SOUTH ELKHORN WATER DISTRICT CUSTOMER NOTICE

On February 25, 2022, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) accepted for filing Jessamine-South Elkhorn Water District's (Jessamine-South Elkhorn District) application requesting to increase its revenue from water sales by \$178,342, an approximate increase of 7.10 percent. On July 19, 2022, Commission Staff determined Jessamine-South Elkhorn District would require an increase of \$214,944 or 8.56 percent in revenue from water sales. Jessamine-South Elkhorn District requests the PSC approve its recommended revenue requirements and that Jessamine-South Elkhorn District be allowed to implement the revised rates as follows:
