REQUEST NO. 2-1: Explain how a new attacher would determine whether a pole was

"[d]esignated for replacement within two (2) years of the date of its actual replacement for any

reason unrelated to a new attacher's request for attachment," as stated in 807 KAR 5:015 Section

1(10)(b), if the pole was not visibly marked with a colored tag or other indication of replacement.

RESPONSE: With any request to attach to a pole or series of poles, Big Sandy would

provide the requesting entity with a list of poles scheduled to be changed.

REQUEST NO. 2-2: State whether You will visibly mark "Red-tagged poles," as that

term is defined in 807 KAR 5:015, with colored tags or in some other manner. If You will mark

the poles with colored tags, state which colors You will use, and what those colors signify.

RESPONSE: A pole marked with a "red-tag" would be considered as priority

replacement due to the physical condition. Any pole scheduled to be changed in less than 2-years

will be marked with orange ribbon and/or tag.

REQUEST NO. 2-3: Identify the average amount of time You spend per pole on a pre-

construction survey.

RESPONSE: Big Sandy estimates that a pre-construction survey, and post construction

survey would last approximately 6 minutes per pole. Travel time to jobsite would equal an average

of 30 minutes each way. Please note; this would simply be a pre-construction survey to make sure

there are no problems along the route an attacher is requesting to use. Actual engineering and

staking is not included in this cost.

In addition, a staking tech would need to spend office time reviewing the application and

locating the request on Big Sandy's mapping system, as well as preparing all necessary materials

needed to be taken on the preconstruction survey.

After the field visit, the tech would be required to record his findings and notify the Line

Superintendent. Upon Superintendent's approval, the tech would then need to notify the attacher

and record the response.

overlashing/additional load on poles will be much greater over the next 5-10 years than ever

before," including any projections of any increase in overlashing for the area You serve. See

Response to KBCA RFI 1-2.

RESPONSE: Wireline attachers have been awarded \$2,084,064 in federal subsidies for

rural broadband deployment in counties served by Big Sandy. We project this to translate to 1,145

new attachments over the next 6 year period. Historically, Big Sandy has not allowed third party

overlashing so there is no existing data to project what the mix of new contact attachments to

overlashing.

REQUEST NO. 2-7: Identify the amount of money, in dollars, that electric cooperatives

or their members have incurred each year for the past five years as a result of third party

communications attachments that are not covered by non-recurring charges, such as pre-

construction survey fees, make ready charges, or recurring annual rental payments from attachers.

RESPONSE: Big Sandy has no recorded amounts, but this does not mean that we have

no costs. Big Sandy staff members spend time reviewing the permit submittals which is currently

not billed to attachers. This is intended to be covered by the survey fee under the new tariff. The

only bills attachers currently receive are for make ready construction costs and annual rental rate.

This also assumes no attachers have attached to Big Sandy poles without submitting a permit

request, which would make it impossible to measure costs.
