Please find enclosed and accept for filing Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc.'s quarterly Gas Cost Adjustment ("GCA"). The data is submitted pursuant to the requirements of the Gas Cost Adjustment Provision contained in Columbia's tariff for its June quarterly adjustment. In accordance with 807 KAR 5:001, Section 8, and the Commission's Order of July 22, 2021 in Case No. 2020-00085, I certify that the electronically filed documents are true and, that there are currently no parties in this proceeding that the Commission has excused from participation by electronic means.

Columbia proposes to increase its current rates to tariff sales customers by \$2.6093 per Mcf effective with its June 2022 billing cycle on May 31, 2022. The increase is composed of a increase of \$3.0851 per Mcf in the Average Commodity Cost of Gas, an increase of \$.0418 per Mcf in the Average Demand Cost of Gas, an increase of \$0.0400 per Mcf in the Balancing Adjustment, a decrease of \$0.3844 in the Actual Cost Adjustment, an increase of \$0.1759 in the Performance Based Rate Adjustment and a Supplier Refund Adjustment of (\$0.3491). The Supplier Refund Adjustment is the result of the Final Order of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission in Docket No. RP20-1060.
