Filing Requirement

A complete report of the applicant's public involvement program activities undertaken prior to the filing of the application, including: 1. The scheduling and conducting of a public meeting in the county or counties in which the proposed facility will be constructed at least ninety (90) days prior to the filing of an application, for the purpose of informing the public of the project being considered and receiving comment on it; 2. Evidence that notice of the time, subject, and location of the meeting was published in the newspaper of general circulation in the county, and that individual notice was mailed to all owners of property adjoining the proposed project at least two (2) weeks prior to the meeting; and 3. Any use of media coverage, direct mailing, fliers, newsletters, additional public meetings, establishment of a community advisory group, and any other efforts to obtain local involvement in the siting process (KRS 278.706(2)(f))

Sebree II has undertaken an extensive public outreach effort that exceeds the minimum requirements of the statute. As detailed below, this effort includes numerous in-person meetings with landowners, local officials and community leaders, a public meeting, office hours, and establishing a Project website and Facebook page to enable continued communication with the local community.

In July 2022, Sebree II established a shared website for the Sebree and Sebree II Projects. The website includes information concerning the description of the Project, an overview of solar power generation, frequently asked questions, contact information, and a means by which individuals could seek additional information about the Project. Sebree II also established a shared Facebook page with Sebree in July 2022 to provide more frequent updates and developments on the Project and to address questions and comments from the public. The Project's Facebook page is:

In adherence to Sebree II's commitment to transparent communication, the Project held multiple local events, public meetings, and sponsorships with the local community. Sebree II conducted an in-person public meeting that was held at Atkinson Park, Henderson Kentucky from 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on July 27, 2022.

Additionally, in support of a request from the Mayor of Robards, Kentucky, Sebree II conducted a public in-person office hours event at the City Hall in Robards, Kentucky from 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. on September 14, 2022. This was noticed according to *KRS 278.706(2)(f))* requirements. It was also advertised on the City of Robards electronic noticing board a week in advance, the City of Robards Facebook page, and the Project's Facebook page. The in-person office hours event at the City Hall in Robards, Kentucky was well-attended with approximately 20-25 people attending throughout the day.

During and following the public office hours held in the City Hall of Robards, KY on September 14, 2022, several landowners expressed interest in including their land in the Project and subsequent negotiations were successfully concluded or are expected to conclude in the first half of 2023 on six additional parcels. Sebree II has elected to include these six additional parcels in the Construction Certificate application. In doing so, Sebree II attests that the new adjoining property owners to these newly added project parcels were not individually notified of the public meeting events, as the public meeting occurred prior to the inclusion of the property in the project.

However, Sebree II attests that all owners of property adjoining the project area, including those adjoining these six additional parcels, have been notified via certified mail on the Public Notice of Intent to File Application in accordance with $KRS\ 278.706(2)(c)$. Additionally, Sebree II sent hand-written cards to the new adjoining property owners, notifying them of the Project and providing direct contact information of the project manager. The new adjoining property owners that were not notified of the Public Meeting events are listed below:
