Notice is hereby given that the Breathitt County Water District expects to file an application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission on or about March 15, 2023, seeking approval of a proposed adjustment to its water rates. The proposed rates shall not become effective until the Public Service Commission has issued an order approving these rates.

If the Public Service Commission approves the proposed water rates, then the monthly bill for a residential customer using an average of 3,000 gallons per month will increase from \$44.48 to \$69.78. This is an increase of \$25.30 or 56.88%.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by Breathitt County Water District. However, the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates. Such action may result in rates for consumers other than the rates shown in this notice.

Breathitt County Water District has available for inspection at its office the application which it submitted to the Public Service Commission. A person may submit a timely written request for intervention to the Public Service Commission, PO Box 615, Frankfort, Ky, 40602, establishing the grounds for the request including the status and interest of the party. If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the application.

WHAT IS A CLAIM?

A "claim" means a right to seek payment or other compensation from another loved one who was harmed by Endo or a related company, including Systems (AMS), or their products, including opioids, ranitidine, or other drugs. You may have a claim against one or more of these entities. To make proof of claim in the bankruptcy case, you may file a claim in the bankruptcy court. You may file a claim for care (including a child exposed to opioids in the womb) Examples of claims that may be filed in the Endo bankruptcy case include:

- > **Opioid Claims:** Claims for death, addiction or dependence or neonatal abstinence syndrome (sometimes referred to as "kicking").
- > **Ranitidine claims:** Claims for cancer, including bladder, stomach, and liver cancer, among others.
- > **Transvaginal mesh claims:** Claims for pelvic pain, incontinence, and other complications.

WHAT DO YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE BAR DATE AND DEADLINE?

The deadline to submit your proof of claim is called a bar date. The bar date, which is the deadline to submit your proof of claim, is **July 7, 2023, at 5:00 p.m.** (proof of claim by the deadline, you will lose any right to compensation. You must file a proof of claim form so that your proof of claim form can be filed by you, a legal guardian, surrogate, or someone acting in your best interests. You do not need an attorney to file a proof of claim form.)
