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**MOTION TO SUBMIT CASE FOR ADJUDICATION  
ON THE ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD**

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Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), by counsel, and, for itself and on behalf of its sixteen Owner-Members, hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to submit the case for a decision based upon the existing record and without the need for a hearing, respectfully stating as follows:

On June 3, 2022, the Commission issued an Order opening an investigation for four six-month reviews and a two-year review of EKPC’s environmental surcharge and pass-through mechanisms. The June 3, 2022 Order contained a procedural schedule that allowed for the filing of direct testimony, data requests, and a deadline for motions to intervene in the case. EKPC and its Owner-Members have provided all of the requested information and there have been no motions for intervention filed in this case. EKPC and its Owner-Members have until September 27, 2022, to request a hearing or submit the case for a decision on the existing record.

Since the remainder of the procedural schedule only applies to intervenors, and there are no intervenors in this case, EKPC and its Owner-Members believe the administrative record is complete and it would be appropriate for the Commission to make a ruling based upon the record. EKPC and its Owner-Members respectfully request a decision from the Commission based upon the existing record.

WHEREFORE, EKPC and its Owner-Members move the Commission to submit the case on the existing administrative record.
