## NOTICE:

The City of Bardstown hereby provides notice that it filed with the Public Service Commission on November 11, 2019 to increase its rates to the North Nelson and Larue County No. 1 Water Districts. In addition the proposed rate schedule will also apply to the cities of Bloomfield and New Haven.

The Current Rate is $\$ 2.00$ per thousand gallons and was last raised in 2013. New rates are proposed to be implemented in five incremental steps, the first become effective for water service rendered on and after January 1, 2020 with a new rate per 1,000 gallons to become effective each July $1^{\text {st }}$ as forth below:

If the Public Service Commission does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the providing of this notice, the Public Service Commission may take final action on the filing.

## RESOLUTION NO. 2022-06-13

## A RESOLUTION OF LARUE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 1 ADJUSTING ITS WATER RATES TO OFFSET THE CITY OF BARDSTOWNS' WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, the City of Bardstown supplies potable water to Larue County Water District No. 1 on a wholesale basis'

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2019 Bardstown filed an application with the PSC seeking to increase the wholesale water rate that Bardstown charges the District. Bardstown's application requested multiple step increases staring on July 1, 2020 and continuing each July 1 until July 1, 2023. The PSC approved Bardstown's application on January 1, 2020 (See PSC Case TFS2019-00625). Effective July 1, 2022, Bardstown's wholesale rate will increase from $\$ 2.56$ per 1,000 gallons to $\$ 2.64$ per 1,000 gallons;

WHEREAS, based upon the water purchases from the City of Bardstown during the previous 12 months, the estimated annual increased cost to Larue Count Water District No. 1 will be $\$ \mathbf{3 , 0 7 6 . 6 2}$;

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that Larue County
Water District take action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with the City of Bardstown's wholesale rate increase; and

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provide the legal mechanism for Larue County Water District No. 1 to increase its water rates to commensurate with the City of Bardstown's wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA")

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LARUE COUNTY WATER DISTRICT NO. 1 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The PWA factor is $\mathbf{\$ . 0 2}$ per 1,000 gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of water usage and the wholesale water rate set forth in Larue County Water District No. 1's existing tariff shall be increased by $\mathbf{\$ . 0 2}$ per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the water system of Larue County Water District No. 1 shall be as set forth in Exhibit C, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. The rates set forth in Exhibit C are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly rates shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after July 1, 2022 upon PSC
approval.

Section 5. The Chairman and the General Manager are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The Chairman, General Manager, and all appropriate Larue County Water District No. 1 Staff are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
