In support of this Application, Applicant respectfully provides and states the following information in response to condition number 3, specified in Order granting the CPCN:



Good Afternoon Crystal,

No, I'm sorry but unfortunately your application was not submitted to us in time. The cutoff for the December meeting was November 8th. By Kentucky statute we have to cut off receipts of the applications 30 days prior to the meeting. That is because we have to run the studies, solidify for the agenda, publish the proposed agenda on our website, and US Mail those studies to the effected airports 20 days prior to the meeting for the purposes of advance public notification.
