Ladies and Gentlemen:

In Accordance with the "Resolution of the Bowling Green Municipal Utilities Board and the Commissioners of the Warren County Water District" dated January 8, 1996, and the "Agreed Order" dated February 27, 1996 in Kentucky Public Service Commission Case No. 95-044, the representatives of BGMU and WCWD have met and calculated wholesale rate adjustments. It is our joint recommendation that the following charges (FY 21 Rates) be implemented that includes the fourth of four-tiered increases on revenue bond debt service for the WTP expansion and Veterans force main projects:

The comments below are pertinent to these rate calculations and have been agreed upon by the respective staffs:

- a. Expenses and operations data for BGMU's fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 are the basis for these rates, except:
  1. Known BGMU wage and salary adjustments subsequent to FY 2021,
  2. Annual payment on Barren River Lake Reservoir water storage allocation agreement with USACOE,
  3. Known pre-unit percentage rate increases in water treatment and sewer treatment plant chemicals, and sewer treatment plant biosolid disposal subsequent to FY 2021, and
  4. Adjustments from GASB Statement No. 68 (pension) and 75 (OPEB) back to a cash requirements basis. Future years may involve positive "add backs" to again represent cash contribution rates, not GASB accrual accounting entries.
- b. Added the following capital assets:
  - Aggregate joint-use water and sewer projects completed since the last rate study's base year (2017) not funded through coverage payments during the same period.
- c. Pro forma debt service on the WTP expansion project was subjected to allocation factors agreed to in a Memorandum of Agreement dated December 4, 2018. One element of the WTP expansion project's pro forma debt service was a capital asset loan primarily representing the Bale, Hampton and Blanton property purchases, along with the appraised value of the displaced Water Sewer Crews buildings and design-period interest on the KIA loan. Another element of the WTP expansion project's pro forma debt service is the 2019 revenue bond. WCWD's allocated debt service on the proposed bonds has been tiered for the first four years with interest being capitalized.
- d. Pro forma debt service on the Veterans force main project was based on the established allocation factors per the Memorandum of Agreement dated December 15, 2020. The Veterans force main project's pro forma debt service is based on the 2019 revenue bond. WCWD's allocated debt service on the proposed bonds has been tiered for the first four years with interest being capitalized.
- e. Pro forma debt service included in these rates on the WTP expansion project and the Veterans force main project were based on estimated loan amounts and

interest rates. True-up adjustments (+/-) between actual and estimated debt service for the period of these new rates will be included in the next wholesale rate.


- f. Catch-up and prospective property insurance premiums on the Cemetery Road pump station building and contents through the rate period, and outstanding Double Springs Road force main repair order were set up as short-term, two-year capital assets for cost recovery.
- g. Higher year-over-year growth in metered sales by WCWD has the effect of over-collecting on fixed cost components (i.e., fixed debt service, etc.) inside wholesale rates. Alternatively, BGMU has no recovery mechanism for inflationary increases on operating costs incurred within the normal two-year rate cycle. Staff for both utilities will review acceptable mechanisms of how over-collection and under-collection can be mitigated and credited, as appropriate.
- h. Interest income from the 2019 revenue bond accounts (construction, paying and reserve) were allocated to WCWD bond on the proportional debt service paid in the previous year. Interest income from the 2019 revenue bond accounts in 2020/2021 (YEAR 2) allocated significantly more interest income than actually earned as bank rates dropped precipitously in March 2020.
- i. It was noted that annual swings in WWTP pretreatment surcharges related to WTP operations can occur. The pretreatment surcharges, primarily related to the extra treatment costs of the WTP's high-concentrate of total suspended solids (TSS), namely river mud, can create annual deviations in wholesale sewer costs making retail rate management difficult. River mud TSS are caused by the frequency and intensity of rain events which can vary from year to year. Future wholesale rate studies will attempt to develop a process to ensure the proper collection of treatment costs averaged over a period of time.
- j. These rates will be effective no later than September 1, 2022.

# RESOLUTION 2022-06-06

## A RESOLUTION OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE WARREN COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

**WHEREAS**, an agreed order issued by the Commonwealth of Kentucky before the Public Service Commission set forth in Case No 95-044 directed that Bowling Green Municipal Utilities (“BGMU”) and Warren County Water District (“WCWD”) jointly create a “Joint Engineering, Planning, and Finance Committee” (“Committee”) to oversee and develop the implementation of long range plans for the development and expansion of water and sewer service by BGMU and WCWD, to include the necessary capital improvements needed for such service, and:


**WHEREAS**, the Committee met in March 2019 to approve wholesale water and sewer rate increases over a four-year period, reflecting debt service for the Water Treatment Plant’s (“WTP”) Alternate Disinfection project and scheduled tiered increases in debt service related to the WTP Expansion and Veterans force main projects, and:

**WHEREAS**, wholesale water and sewer rates need to reflect the fourth and final year of the tiered increases in debt service and operational costs as shown below:





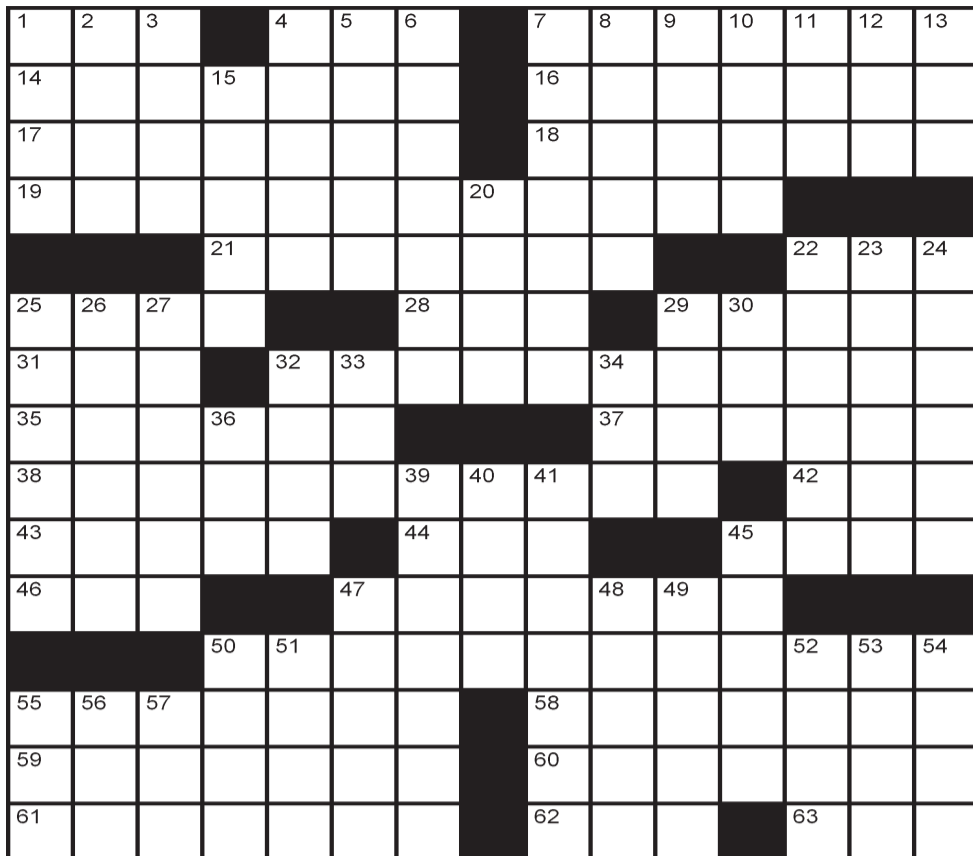
