Dear Ms. Bridwell:

Please let this letter serve as Kentucky Frontier Gas, LLC's ("Kentucky Frontier") comments to the PSC Letter Filing Document into the Record dated April 19, 2023. Upon review of the information provided in the response to counsel for East Kentucky Midstream, LLC's ("EKM") email, Kentucky Frontier believes that the inquiry from EKM's counsel was in regards to its farm tap tariff that it is to file by May, 1, 2023 in Case No. 2023-00112. However, if this inquiry by EKM's counsel was also in regards to establishing a wholesale rate for Kentucky Frontier, which is a regulated utility, Kentucky Frontier would object to the rate being increased to the amount contained in the Commission's response. Kentucky Frontier believes that the rate it has been paying to EKM is already giving EKM a one hundred percent (100%) return on equity for the Jefferson Gas system that EKM purchased and should be decreased, not increased. The wholesale rate to be charged by EKM should be fair, just and reasonable.

This is to certify that the electronic filing has been transmitted to the Commission on April 24, 2023 and that there are currently no parties in this proceeding that the Commission has excused from participation by electronic means. Pursuant to the Commission's July 22, 2021 Order in Case No. 2020-00085 no paper copies of this filing will be made.
