9. Provide all current rates being charged to all classes of customers, residential or commercial, and any changes to those rates, whether increase or decrease, since acquisition.
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Response

There have been no changes to contract prices since acquisition of Jefferson Gas assets in March 2021. The current charges are as follows.

Kentucky Frontier Gas

Locally Produced Gas: First of the Month – TCO Appalachian Index + \$5.75/Dth

Transport Fee + 12% LAUF

Interstate Gas from TCO (Delivered via TCO at Means Station): Variable Rate from

Third Party Marketer (at exact cost) + \$5.75/Dth Transport Fee + 12% LAUF

West Liberty Municipality

Interstate Gas from TCO (Delivered via TCO at Means Station): First of the Month –

NYMEX Index + \$5.63/Dth

West Liberty Prison

Interstate Gas from TCO (Delivered via TCO at Means Station): First of the Month –

NYMEX + \$5.13/Dth

EKM Farm Taps

TCO Appalachian Index + \$5.75/Dth + \$2.00/Dth (LAUF & Meter Reading)

SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE:

Prior to acquisition, Jefferson Gas is believed to have increased the contract price for Ky Frontier and rates for farm tap customers from \$3.25/Dth to \$5.75/Dth in October 2020. Effective 11/1/20 the price to Kentucky Frontier was TCO Index + \$5.75/Dth. That contract expired 4/30/21, after EKM's March 2021 acquisition.

The first gas supply agreement between EKM and Ky Frontier went into effect on May 1, 2021. This included a Transport Fee of \$5.75/Dth. The agreement also contains a 12% Lost And Unaccounted For (LAUF) provision and addresses Local Gas "First Through the Meter.

EKM then entered a second agreement with Ky Frontier effective 10/1/21, with a monthly evergreen provision. This included a transport fee of \$5.75/Dth and LAUF provision as well as local gas first through the meter and interstate gas sales and purchases as second through the meter, where the purchase price is established by third party marketer (i.e. Southern Energy).

Effective May 2, 2021, EKM charged its farm taps a 12% LAUF fee similar to that charged to Kentucky Frontier.
