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

Request

1. Provide any and all maps, not previously provided, that have been generated in relation to or that may be deemed relevant to this case.
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Response

East Kentucky Midstream, LLC (“EKM”) has provided topography maps for the KZ lines, A lines and C lines entirely under seal with a concurrently filed motion for confidential treatment.

Request

2. Provide any and all information relating to proposed provision of service or contracted provision of service to Highlands Elementary School and Discount Auto Brokers.
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Response

Both Highlands Elementary School and Discount Auto Brokers were previously customers of Jefferson Gas and became EKM customers upon acquisition in early 2021. The school has been a farm tap customer since approximately 2005; the other has been a farm tap customer approximately a decade or more. There are no special provisions or contractual terms for either farm tap customer other than the proposed tariff in Ky. PSC Case No. 2023-00112. These customers signed up as farm tap customers utilizing a simple post card providing entity name, location address, billing address, etc. to initiate service.
