RESOLUTION NO. 2022-07-25

OF **MUHLENBERG** COUNTY RESOLUTION A ADJUSTING ITS WATER WATER DISTRICT #1 CENTRAL CITY THE RATES TO OFFSET SEWER SYSTEM'S MUNICIPAL WATER AND WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE

WHEREAS, the Central City Municipal and Sewer System ("Central City") supplies potable water to MUHLENBERG COUNTY WATER DISTRICT #1("District") on a wholesale basis;

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2022, Central City sent notice to Muhlenberg County Water District that it plans to file notice with Kentucky Public Service Commission ("PSC") seeking to increase the wholesale water rate that Central City charges the District from \$3.31 to \$3.81 per 1,000 gallons on August 31, 2022

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that the Central City will file its notice with the PSC and that the new wholesale rate will become effective on or about August 31, 2022.

WHEREAS, based upon the water purchases from Central City during the previous 12 months, the estimated annual increased cost to the District will be **\$229.406**:

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that the District take immediate action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with Central City's wholesale rate increase; and

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provide the legal mechanism for the District to increase its water rates commensurate with Central City's wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA");

NOW, THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MUHLENBERG COUNTY WATER DISTRICT #1 DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The PWA factor is <u>\$.64</u> per 1,000 gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of water usage and the wholesale water rate set forth in the District's existing tariff shall be increased by <u>\$.64</u> per 1,000 gallons, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of the water system of the District shall be as set forth in Appendix A, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a

part of this Resolution. The rates set forth in **Appendix A** are subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the PSC. These monthly rates shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after the effective date of Central City's wholesale rate increase.

Section 5. The Chairman and the General Manager are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the PSC.

Section 6. The Chairman, General Manager, and all appropriate District Staff are hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

Section 7. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.
