A quorum being present, the Chairman called the meeting to order.

The minutes of the March 18th meeting were read and approved on a motion by Troy Norris, second by Mark Vibbert; all in favor.

The Board performed the Financial Review.

The Board discussed the Dale Hollow State Park discount that they receive on their water bill due to an agreement that was signed in 1996. The contract was reviewed and Matthew was asked to have the numbers and information prepared to present at the next meeting.

In the Manager's Report Johnny informed the Board that they did purchase a new turbocharger for the Dump Truck. It has been installed and seems to be working fine now. He also discussed a 3" main line under the road on top of Modoc Hill that they had repaired last week that had been leaking for some time. Johnny also brought up the fact that the surrounding Fire Departments have not been turning in their monthly water usage reports. Any Fire Department that fails to issue a report is supposed to be charged for the water used. Matthew was asked to look back in the previous minutes to find any information regarding this issue.

Garland Hieneman, Troy Norris and Mark Vibbert will be attending PSC training for New Commissioners at Lake Barkley State Park on April 9th and 10th.

The Board discussed changing the policy pertaining to our seasonal customers that come and go frequently, having their water service disconnected and reconnected throughout the year. No decision was made at this time. After more information is obtained the Board will discuss this issue at a later date.

Johnny Carter and Matthew Dyer were asked to leave so that the Board could go into "closed session" to discuss a few matters.

Kentucky Revised Statute 74.020 sets training requirements for water district commissioners and gives the Kentucky Public Service Commission the overall responsibility for water district management training programs. KRS 74.020(8) requires newly appointed water district commissioners to undergo 12 hours of training within one year of taking office. Beginning in 2018, the only approved training for new commissioners has been the seminars offered by the Kentucky Public Service Commission. The training offered by the Kentucky Public Service Commission also may be used to fulfill the six hours of continuing education required for water district commissioners who desire additional annual compensation.

WATER DISTRICT COMMISSIONERS: BE SURE YOU REGISTER FOR THE SEMINAR OFFERING THE AMOUNT OF CREDITS THAT YOU ARE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN. NOTE: THE ONE-DAY TRAINING ON JUNE 4, 2019, AT BARREN RIVER SRP OFFERS CREDIT FOR RETURNING COMMISSIONERS ONLY

The Kentucky Department of Environmental Protection grants Continuing Learning Education credits through these programs. Operators and engineers may earn up to 12 hours of credit. The Kentucky Bar Association also recognizes these seminars for up to 12 hours of CLE. Please make sure to mark the desired CLE when registering.
