AMENDED UNOPPOSED MOTION TO AMEND THE PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE AND REQUEST FOR EXPEDITED TREATMENT

On February 9, 2023, Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc. (Duke Energy Kentucky or the Company) filed an Unopposed Motion to Amend the Procedural Schedule and Request for Expedited Treatment, stating that it anticipated being able to finalize a settlement with the Kentucky Attorney General, Office of Rate Intervention (AG) by February 28, 2023. Duke Energy Kentucky hereby files this Amended Unopposed Motion to amend the anticipated date by which the Company anticipates finalizing and filing a settlement to March 10, 2023. Apart from this change to the anticipated date of finalization and filing of a settlement, Duke Energy Kentucky makes no other changes to its February 9, 2023, motion requesting that the Kentucky Public Service Commission (Commission) amend the procedural schedule in its September 2, 2022 Order and continue the date for the hearing currently scheduled for February 22, 2023.

The continuance is requested due to Duke Energy Kentucky and the AG (collectively referred to as, the Parties) being near settlement, and so that the Commission has ample time to review the proposed settlement and then prepare for a hearing on the remaining relevant issues, if necessary.

Additionally, Duke Energy Kentucky respectfully requests expedited treatment of

its Motion. Said expedited treatment will enable the Parties to finish settlement discussions

without the added pressure of preparing for an upcoming hearing. Duke Energy Kentucky

anticipates that the Parties will be able to finalize a settlement for filing on or before March

10, 2023. The AG has confirmed to Duke Energy Kentucky that it does not object to this

request.

WHEREFORE, Duke Energy Kentucky respectfully requests the Commission

grant its Amended Unopposed Motion and Request for Expedited Treatment.
