**REQUEST:**

Explain whether Duke Kentucky has evaluated a Prepaid Electric Program. If so, provide the supporting documentation and an explanation why it is not offered.

**RESPONSE:**

The Company has not done a detailed evaluation regarding Duke Energy Kentucky offering a prepaid electric program. Due to the complexity associated with combined electric gas customers with consolidated bills, evaluating a program in Kentucky has not been done to date. The Company is monitoring Duke Energy prepaid program offerings in other jurisdictions with respect to the ability to potentially integrate prepaid with its behavioral EE program platforms. This is another difference that will need to be factored into any future evaluations, because Duke Energy Kentucky was ordered by the Commission to operate its behavioral EE program on an opt-in basis, which is different from other jurisdictions.

**REQUEST:**

Refer to Duke Kentucky's response to Commission Staff's First Request for Information, Item 1. Confirm that Duke Kentucky will consider continuing a type of peak rebate program if the results of the increased incentive study provide additional insights.

**RESPONSE:**

Confirmed. Consistent with the Company's response to STAFF-DR-01-001, -007 and -008, there are multiple programs the Company is considering. The results of the PTR incentive test during the summer of 2022 will provide additional insight to help determine next steps. The Company will consider a type of peak rebate program guided by the additional information referenced above as it becomes available.
