electric gas customers with consolidated bills, evaluating a program in Kentucky has not

been done to date. The Company is monitoring Duke Energy prepaid program offerings in

other jurisdictions with respect to the ability to potentially integrate prepaid with its

behavioral EE program platforms. This is another difference that will need to be factored

into any future evaluations, because Duke Energy Kentucky was ordered by the

Commission to operate its behavioral EE program on an opt-in basis, which is different

from other jurisdictions.
