TAB 11 ENVIRONMENTAL VIOLATION RECORD

KRS 278.706(2)(k) A detailed listing of all violations by it, or any person with an ownership interest, of federal or state environmental laws, rules, or administrative regulations, whether judicial or administrative, where violations have resulted in criminal convictions or civil or administrative fines exceeding five thousand dollars (\$5,000). The status of any pending action, whether judicial or administrative, shall also be submitted.

Bright Mountain Solar, LLC has no violations of federal or state environmental laws, rules, or administrative regulations resulting in criminal convictions or civil or administrative fines exceeding \$5,000.

Bright Mountain Solar, LLC is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Avangrid Renewables, LLC, which has one item to list in an abundance of caution. To that end, Avangrid Renewables, LLC and six of its wholly-owned, project-company subsidiaries entered into a Settlement Agreement with the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service in 2016, in a matter that involved alleged violations of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act and the Bald and Golden Eagle Protection Act. None of the parties admitted the alleged violations, but agreed to a compromise civil penalty of \$25,000. The parties performed their obligations under the Settlement Agreement, and the matter is fully resolved.
