TAB 3 PUBLIC NOTICE EVIDENCE

Another letter of public notice was sent to all landowners whose property borders the Facility Area or is part of the Transmission Line Route on August 31, 2023. A sample of each letter, along with a list of all names and addresses to which they were sent, is included in this Tab as Attachment B.

Additionally, public notice was published in the *Hazard Herald* on December 15, 2022 and again on September 7, 2023. The *Hazard Herald* is a newspaper of general circulation in Perry County. Affidavits from the *Hazard Herald* as proof of the publications are also included in Attachment B.

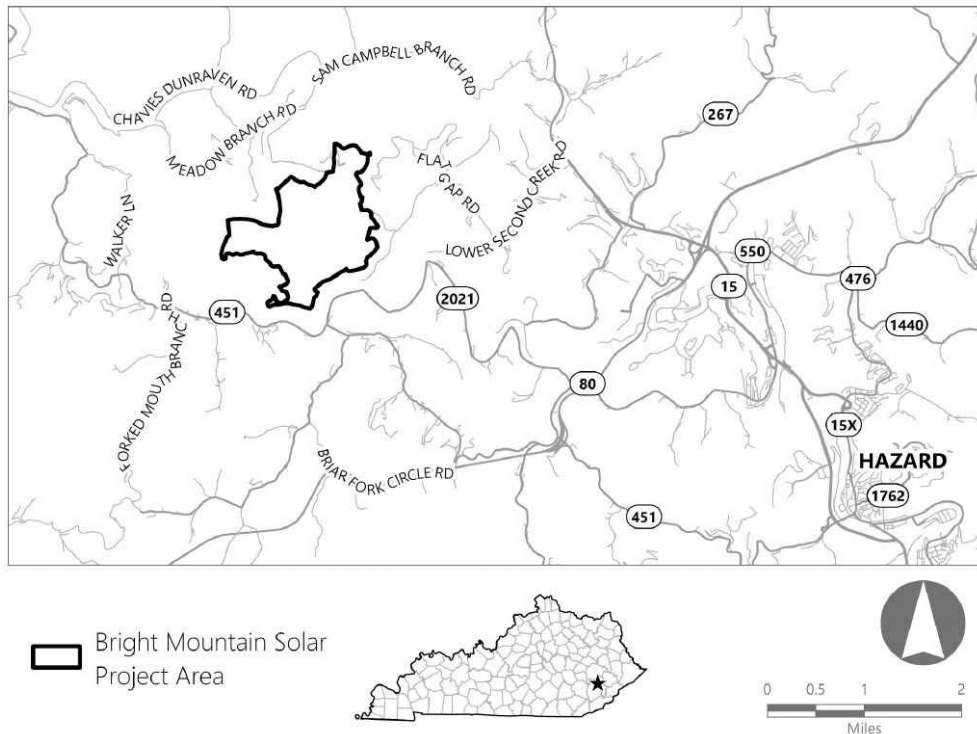

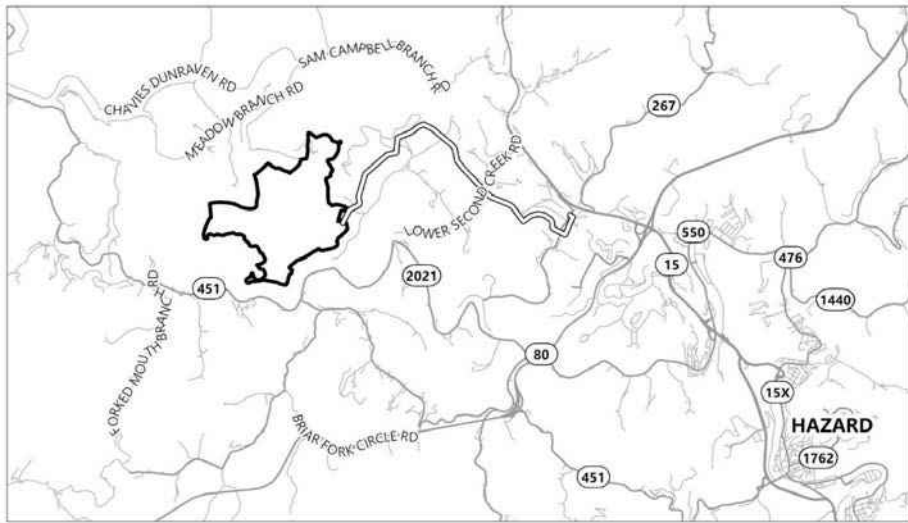

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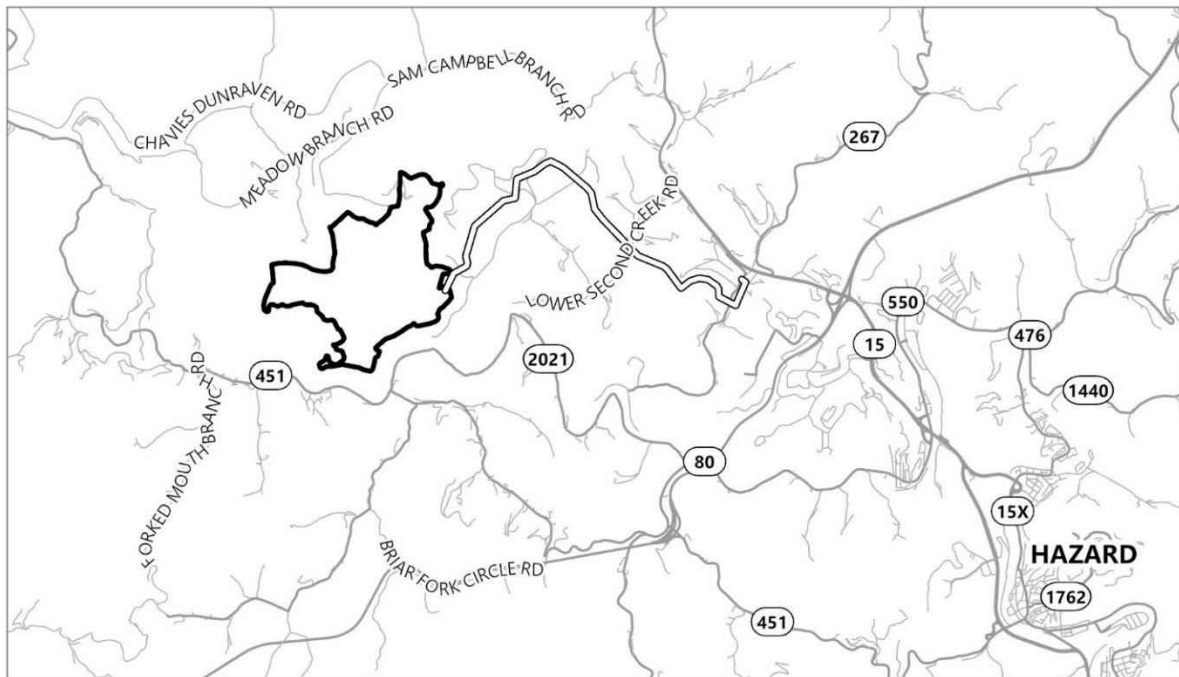
