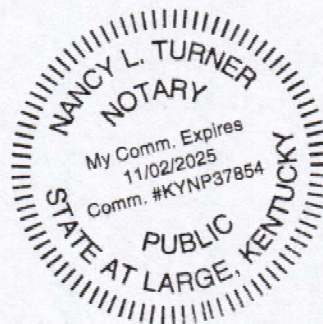

Notice is hereby given pursuant to KRS 278.023 and 807 KAR 5:069, Section 3, that the Hardin County Water District No. 1 (District) plans to file an Application with the Kentucky Public Service Commission (PSC) seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience And Necessity authorizing construction of additions and improvements to its water system and authorizing the issuance of certain securities pursuant to the provisions of KRS 278.023 and 807 KAR 5:069, and approval of revised water service rates as follows:

The District proposes to place the rates into effect for all water used after December 1, 2022. The District's last general water rate increase was in May, 2017. The proposed rates are required under terms of an agreement (Letter of Conditions dated July 15, 2021) between the District and the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Rural Development ("RD") under which RD will lend the District up to \$994,400. This RD loan will be used for the Pirtle Spring Water Treatment Plant Improvements, Gray Lane Pump Station Improvements, and Brizendine Tank Booster Pump Station. KRS 278.023 does not grant the PSC any discretionary authority to modify or reject any portion of the agreement between RD and the District or to defer the issuance of all necessary orders to implement the terms of the agreement.
