Sharpsburg Water District does not own any utility trucks. James Purvis uses his own personal vehicles for water district related activities. He has been employed with the district since 1986 and has always used his own truck. Minutes will reflect the increase from \$15.00 per day to \$20.00 per day. May 14, 2008

The Sharpsburg Water District board of commissioners met at the water office in regular session at 7:00 pm.

Members present: Jim Jones, Becky Ritchie, Randy Warner, and William Grayson. Also present, George Purvis and Gayle Haney.
