GCWD goes to great lengths to ensure accuracy with our markings for locates. GCWD has a variety of tools and options for marking from manually locating with a punch rod to using a Tremble unit that can achieve accuracy within 6-12 inches.

2h. State what policies and procedures have been implemented to reduce the number of inaccurately located facilities.

GCWD currently has no official policies or procedures for this. Our locators use every tool available to them on a daily basis to provide the most reliable markings to excavators, homeowners and contractors.
