**RESPONSES OF KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY**

The Public Service Commission of Kentucky (“Commission”) initiated this proceeding to investigate jurisdictional utilities’ compliance with excavator locate requests made pursuant to the Underground Facility Damage Prevention Act of 1994 (Act) (KRS 367.4901–KRS 367.4917).<sup>1</sup> The Commission ordered that each utility shall file the information included herein within 45 days of the date of service of the opening order.<sup>2</sup> Kentucky Power Company (“Kentucky Power” or the “Company”) files the following responses:

**A. Since January 1, 2022, the number of locate requests received in total and broken out into the types of locate requests contained in KRS 367.4909(5);**

Locate requests are broken into the ticket types within KRS 367.4909(5) as described in table 2a below. Ticket count totals include both initial and subsequent requests.

**D. Since January 1, 2022, the number of times an agreement has been reached with an excavator outside the statutory time limits required by KRS 367.4909, with the aggregate numbers and broken out into the types of locate requests contained in KRS 367.4909(5);**

The number of times that locates were outside the statutory time limits are described in table 2d below. Of the 1,391 locates that were addressed outside the statutory time limits, the Company’s third-party contractor notified the excavator (1,065 tickets), when a name and phone number was listed.

- E. Since January 1, 2022, state whether locate requests have been performed by Utility personnel or by a third-party contractor. If the answer is both, provide the number of locate requests performed by Utility personnel and third-party contractors, respectively;**

Kentucky Power Company utilizes a third-party contractor for all locates.

- F. State whether records and statistics are kept of the number of underground facilities located accurately versus inaccurately. Provide all records and statistics compiled since January 1, 2022;**

The Company’s database for ticket locate requests does not distinguish between accurate versus inaccurate locates. The database does allow for “Damage” coding. Coding tickets as “Damage” indicates that there was dig-in, and potential resulting damage, to the Company’s facilities by the excavator. However, because facilities were damaged does not necessarily mean that the damage resulted from an inaccurate locate. There are multiple variables that can cause a dig-in. There were 11 such instances where a ticket type was coded “Damage” for the first three quarters of 2022. Attached as **Exhibit 1** are the Company’s records for these 11 instances. From

the descriptions, it was determined that two were electrical damage. However, this does not mean that they were inaccurately marked.

**G. Explain the method used to determine whether an underground facility has been located accurately versus inaccurately;**

If the Company has damaged facilities from a dig-in, the Company and/or its third-party contractor would investigate. The Company would initially determine if there was a locate ticket on record for the address of the dig-in and whether the locates were valid or stale (meaning whether the mark was made more than 21 days prior). If a valid locate was recorded, the Company and/or its third-party contractor would take measurements from the damaged facility to the locate marking. Depending on whether the measurements were within tolerance,<sup>4</sup> the Company could send a bill for facility damages to excavator or the locating contractor.

**H. State what policies and procedures have been implemented to reduce the number of inaccurately located facilities. Provide information detailing the efficacy of those procedures on reducing the number of inaccurately located underground facilities.**

The Company engages a third-party contractor for all locates. Within that contract, the Company includes processes and procedures aimed at reducing the number of inaccurately located facilities, which include but are not limited to:

- Detailed facilities marking requirements and guidelines. For example:

When no facilities are found to be located within the scope of the locate request, or there is not a positive response the Contractor is required to paint a marking on the ground or place flags stating same.

The Contractor is responsible to respond to each locate request. The Contractor's personnel must personally verify every requested location even if no underground facilities are shown on Company prints.

If Contractor has other underground facility locating customers within the Company's service area supported by Contractor and Contractor is on site locating at an address and has reason to believe that the Company has underground facilities at that location, but the Contractor has not received a locate request from the Company for the address, the Contractor will contact a Company representative and request instructions.

- Detailed dig-in reporting and investigation procedures.

For example, in the instance of a reported dig-in the Contractor is required to detail a report to the Company including time actual dig-in was reported, the location of the reported dig-in, any known circumstances surrounding the dig-in, the name of firm and/or individual causing reported damage, and the Contractor's estimated time of arrival to begin damage investigation.
