UNION COUNTY WATER DISTRICT

- (A) Since Jan. 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, Union County water District has had 567 locate request.  
Normal request: 429  
Emergency request: 63  
Design request: 2  
Fiber to premises: 73
- (B) Since Jan 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022, Union County Water District has had 57 subsequent requests for Normal locates for excavation and Hwy sign replacement.
- (C) All locate request were completed within allotted time. Normal and Fiber locates where completed within two working days. All Emergency locates where completed same day as request.
- (D) There has been no need for agreements with an excavator or contractor to complete a locate request outside the statutory time limit.
- (E) All locates are preformed by utility personnel.
- (F) No written records have been kept showing the number of accurately versus inaccurately locates performed by Union County Water District personnel.
- (G) (H) The two main methods for locating lines accurately are probing and tracer wire. We also have all valves and hydrants GPS'd to assist in locating. We have GIS mapping on phones and tablets to assist in accurately locating lines.
