**ATTORNEY GENERAL’S REQUEST TO FILE A BRIEF AND RECOMMENDATION
TO SUBMIT ON THE RECORD FOR A FINAL DECISION ON REHEARING**

The intervenor in this proceeding, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, through his Office of Rate Intervention (“Attorney General”), hereby submits his recommendation regarding submission of this case for a final decision on Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc.’s (“Duke Kentucky”) petition for rehearing. Pursuant to the Commission’s November 22, 2023 Order in this matter, the parties are required by February 9, 2024, to either request a hearing or state whether the case can be submitted on the existing record. The Attorney General requests the opportunity to file a brief to address the issues contained in Duke Kentucky’s petition for rehearing. Further, the Attorney General recommends for the case to be submitted on the record for a final decision on Duke Kentucky’s petition for rehearing after briefs have been filed in the pending case. However, if the Commission determines that a public hearing is necessary, then the Attorney General will fully participate in the hearing.
