Answer

The district charges \$1,000.00 for all residential sewer taps. There are 2 different methods for residential sewer hook-ups being: gravity customer laterals and low pressure residential grinder pumps the initial tap itself has no cost to the district outside of an hour labor to inspect the tap for a total of \$75.00, the customer incurs the rest of the cost. However the tap in charge helps with pump and gravity system upkeep and maintenance, as well as treatment costs.

For commercial tap ins the cost of service installation attained by the district is then billed to the customer.
