Please also note the following important information:

- Pursuant to federal regulations at 7 CFR 1970.11(b), the Agency has determined that assured access to ReConnect funding for this Project is necessary for economic rural development. As a result, the enclosed Loan/Grant Agreement with Mortgage is subject to the completion of all necessary environmental procedures required by Federal law. Given that all such procedures have not yet finished on your Project, no work on the Project, whether work which will be reimbursed through federal funds, or work which will be paid for with Awardees own funds, may be engaged until successful completion of the environmental reviews. Awardee acknowledges that unless it has received written notice from the Agency, it will not engage in any work on the Project, under any circumstances, except for that required to finalize the environmental reviews. Failure to abide by this requirement will result in the termination of the Loan/Grant with Mortgage Agreement. Additionally, Awardee acknowledges that should any findings in the environmental reviews require significant changes to the Project, and as a result to the Loan/Grant Agreement with Mortgage, such changes will constitute an immediate deobligation of federal funding and the termination of the Loan/Grant Agreement with Mortgage and will not result in an amended agreement until revised terms are agreed upon and funding is determined to be still available.
- The loan Accounting Requirements defined under Article I of the Agreement include 2 CFR Part 200 and RUS Bulletin 1770B-1. Debt service payments are to be made electronically in accordance with Section 3.3 of the Agreement, specifically by means of the Customer Initiated Payment (CIP) Online System; please refer to the eponymous document for further information and enrollment instructions.

In accordance with the Agreement, compliance with RUS Forms 481 ("Financial Requirement Statement") and 675 ("Certificate of Authority") is required for loan and/or grant funding to be advanced. • The project must be constructed and operated in accordance with the Scope of Work submitted as part of your application. If any changes are required, a written request detailing the changes must be submitted for RUS approval. For the changes to be eligible for funding, approval of the revised Scope of Work must be received before the changes are implemented.

- Article VI of the Agreement outlines the requirements for annual audit reports and progress reports. These annual reports are required once any portion of the grant funds have been drawn down. RUS will provide additional information regarding how to comply with audit and progress reporting requirements.
- Please fill out Sections 13 and 14 of the enclosed UCC Forms before filing.
- Your mortgages will be mailed to you for signature. Please execute and record one original copy in each of the 6 counties listed in Schedule B of the Mortgage. Please also execute the remaining 3 originals, retain one for your records, and return the other 2 originals as well as copies of each recorded Mortgage to Mr. Peter Aimable's attention at the address indicated above.
