**RESPONSE OF JOINT INTERVENORS TO KENTUCKY POWER COMPANY’S
MOTION TO AMEND PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

Joint Intervenors Mountain Association (“MA”), Kentuckians for the Commonwealth (“KFTC”), Appalachian Citizens’ Law Center (“ACLC”), Sierra Club, and Kentucky Resources Council, Inc. (“KRC”) (collectively the “Joint Intervenors”) provide this response to the May 22, 2023 Motion of Kentucky Power Company (“KPCO”) to amend the procedural schedule in this case.

KPCO has requested that the hearing that is currently scheduled for June 21, 2023 be rescheduled, and has suggested “a date between July 11-14, 2023 or July 17-21, 2023, or a date thereafter that is convenient to the Commission.”

Joint Intervenors do not oppose the request to reschedule the hearing. However, of the range of dates proposed by KPCO and those offered in response by the Attorney General, only the dates of July 18, 19, or 20, 2023 will work for both counsel and the expert witnesses for Joint Intervenors. If the Commission is inclined to grant KPCO’s request, Joint Intervenors respectfully request that the hearing, which is not expected to extend beyond the one day previously scheduled by the Commission for hearing, be rescheduled to July 18, 19, or 20, 2023 in order to allow Joint Intervenors’ counsel and witnesses to be heard.


