## NOTICE OF CORRECTED TESTIMONY FILING

Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Kentucky Solar Energy Society, Mountain Association, and Metropolitan Housing Coalition (collectively "Joint Intervenors") by counsel, hereby respectfully give notice of the following corrections to the Direct Testimony of Anna Sommer filed on July 14, 2023:

- 1. Direct Testimony of Anna Sommer
  - a. Page 10, line 2-4: strike sentence "In addition, the Brown solar project is a fixed axis project, whereas most utility scale solar projects are tracking axis with higher capacity factors."
  - b. Page 30, table 5: amend costs to read "\$1,399,273,493" and "\$290,378,525."
  - c. Page 32, table 6: amend costs to read "\$993,180,524" and "\$81,887,968."
  - a. Pages 33-34, lines 16, 1-3 (respectively): change "12%" to "4%," strike "and noticeably higher than any of the past seven years," and replace figure 12.
  - b. Page 46, line 6: strike sentence "For natural gas turbines with an intermediate load between 20% to 50% capacity factor, only 30% hydrogen co-firing by

2032 is required with no subsequent requirements," and associated footnote.
