**JOINT INTERVENORS’ MOTION FOR LEAVE TO ALLOW
COUNSEL CASSANDRA MCCRAE TO PARTICIPATE VIRTUALLY**


Come Kentuckians for the Commonwealth, Kentucky Solar Energy Society, Mountain Association, and Metropolitan Housing Coalition (collectively “Joint Intervenors”), by counsel, and respectfully move the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to allow Cassandra McCrae, who is counsel for Joint Intervenors appearing *pro hac vice*, to participate and cross-examine witness(es) virtually at the hearing in this case, currently scheduled for August 28-29, 2023. In support of this motion, Joint Intervenors state the following:

1. On August 24, 2023, Ms. McCrae, who has been admitted to practice *pro hac vice* in this matter by Commission Order dated April 13, 2023, was informed that her spouse and infant child have contracted symptomatic COVID-19. Ms. McCrae will be returning to her home in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, to tend to her family, and consistent with the CDC protocols for persons exposed to symptomatic individuals, will not be able to return to participate in-person at the continuation of the hearing in this matter that is scheduled to resume after a Friday, August 25 recess, on Monday, August 28, 2023.

2. Ms. McCrae possesses the necessary equipment and internet connectivity to allow her participation without issue and will conduct any preliminary check with PSC IT Staff required by the Commission to ensure the ability to so participate.

WHEREFORE, for these reasons, Joint Intervenors respectfully move for the Commission to grant leave for Ms. McCrae to participate and cross-examine witness(es) virtually in the hearing continuation on August 28-29, 2023.


