COMMENTS OF ATMOS ENERGY CORPORATION

I. INTRODUCTION

Atmos Energy Corporation ("Atmos Energy" or "the Company") appreciates the opportunity to submit comments in this proceeding regarding the review of the Kentucky Public Service Commission's ("Commission") EDX Pilot Program. On January 24, 2020, the Commission issued an Order establishing an administrative case to review the procedure for approval of economic development extensions (EDXs), which are extensions of service in the ordinary course of business to potential economic development projects for gas local distribution companies (LDCs). The Commission, on May 4, 2020, issued an Order establishing the EDX Pilot Program. In the Order, the Commission reminded all parties that the EDX Pilot Program will remain in effect for as long as the Commission deems necessary in order to evaluate the effectiveness of its procedures. The Commission also stated it will internally evaluate the effectiveness of the EDX Pilot Program at any time.

II. DISCUSSION

Atmos Energy Corporation supports economic development and policies that encourage economic development in the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The Company believes that

continued engagement between the Commission and utilities should be encouraged to help further promote economic development. The Company is unaware of an instance in its service territory that has necessitated utilizing the EDX Pilot Program so far but has utilized other options for economic development with Commission approval such as Economic-Development Rider Contracts. To the extent that both the Company and the Commission can provide additional incentives, regulatory certainty, and timely engagement on economic development issues the Company believes that a strong partnership in this area benefits all stakeholders. The Company supports the continuation of the EDX Pilot Program as part of that process to provide potential incentives to further encourage economic development.

III. CONCLUSION

Atmos Energy appreciates the opportunity to offer its comments on the EDX Pilot Program and explore ways to work with the Commission to enhance economic development in the Commonwealth.
