City of Pikeville Notice of Wholesale Rate Increase Approved Tariff Sheet

NOTICE

Notice is hereby given that the City of Pikeville proposes to increase its rate for wholesale water service to Mountain Water District effective December 1, 2022. On or about November 10, 2022, documentation will be filed with the Kentucky Public Service Commission to increase rates as follows:

Current Rates \$1.97 per 1,000 gallons* New Rates \$2.26 per 1,000 gallons

The total dollar amount of the proposed increases are \$8,350.50 monthly based on 28,794,833 gallons per motion, which is an increase of 14.7%.

* This rate is currently being challenged in the Franklin Circuit Court

As you are aware, the contract between Pikeville and Mountain Water District reduces the minimum monthly purchase from 28,000,000 gallons to 20,000,000 gallons.

Pursuant to KRS 278.180, the proposed effective date is December 1, 2022. Water flowing through the meter(s) before the effective date will be charged at the current rate while water flowing through the meter(s) on and after the effective date will be charged at the proposed new rate.

The rates contained in this notice are the rates proposed by the City of Pikeville but the Public Service Commission may order rates to be charged that differ from the proposed rates contained in this notice.

Resolution of Mountain Water District Board of Commissioners Adopting the Proposed Rates

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MOUNTAIN WATER DISTRICT ADJUSTING WATER RATES AND CHARGES TO OFFSET THE WHOLESALE RATE INCREASE OF THE CITY OF PIKEVILLE, KENTUCKY

WHEREAS, the City of Pikeville, Kentucky ("Pikeville") is a wholesale water supplier of Mountain Water District;

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2022, Pikeville and Mountain Water District entered into an Amended Wholesale Water Purchase Agreement to supersede and replace their existing Wholesale Water Purchase Agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the terms of the Amended Wholesale Water Purchase Agreement, Pikeville's rate for water made available for sale to Mountain Water District will increase;

WHEREAS, based upon its water purchases from Pikeville for the period from October 1, 2021 to September 30, 2022, Mountain Water District's annual purchased water costs will increase approximately **\$58,040.32**;

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2022, Pikeville filed the proposed Amended Wholesale Water Purchase Agreement with the Kentucky Public Service Commission and requested that the Kentucky Public Service Commission shorten the required notice for the proposed rate change from 30 days to 20 days and permit the agreed wholesale water rate to take effect on December 1, 2022;

WHEREAS, prudent financial management dictates that Mountain Water District take immediate action to adjust its retail rates commensurate with Pikeville's wholesale rate increase; and

WHEREAS, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068 provide the legal mechanism for Mountain Water District to increase its water rates commensurate with Pikeville's wholesale rate increase via a Purchased Water Adjustment ("PWA");

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF MOUNTAIN WATER DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The facts, recitals, and statements contained in the foregoing preamble of this Resolution are true and correct and are hereby affirmed and incorporated as a part of this Resolution.

Section 2. The PWA factor is \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons;

Section 3. All tiers of all meter sizes of Mountain Water District's existing tariff shall be increased by \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons, effective December 1, 2022, subject to any minor adjustment that may be made by the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

Section 4. The monthly water rates to be charged to and collected from the customers and users of Mountain Water District's water system shall be as set forth in **Appendix A**, which is attached hereto and is incorporated herein by reference as a part of this Resolution. These monthly rates and charges shall be in effect for all water service rendered on and after December 1, 2022.

Section 5. Should the Kentucky Public Service Commission deny Pikeville's request to shorten the notice for the wholesale rate adjustment to 20 days but allow the proposed wholesale rate to take effect after 30 days' notice, then the rates set forth in Appendix A shall become effective for all water service rendered on and after December 11, 2022.

Section 6. Should the Kentucky Public Service Commission suspend Pikeville's proposed wholesale rate for further review, then the rates set forth in Appendix A shall not take effect and Mountain Water District's present rates shall remain in effect until further action by this Board.

Section 7. If the Kentucky Public Service Commission allows the proposed wholesale rate to take effect, the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file the PWA Application, Tariff Sheet, and all other documents that may be required by the Kentucky Public Service Commission.

Section 8. The Chairman and Mountain District's Staff hereby further authorized and directed to take any and all other actions and to execute and deliver any and all other documents as may be reasonably necessary to implement the PWA.

Section 9. This Resolution shall take effect upon its adoption.

NOTICE

On December 10, 2023, the City of Pikeville increased its wholesale water service rate to Mountain Water District from \$1.97 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.26 per 1,000 gallons and reduced the minimum volume of water that Mountain Water District must purchase monthly. On December 11, 2022, Mountain Water District adjusted its rates by \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons to reflect the increase in its cost of purchased water due to the increase in the City of Pikeville's rate for wholesale water service. On December 13, 2022, Mountain Water District applied to the Public Service Commission for approval of the rates set forth below.
