On December 10, 2022, the City of Pikeville increased its wholesale water service rate to Mountain Water District from \$1.97 per 1,000 gallons to \$2.26 per 1,000 gallons and reduced the minimum volume of water that Mountain Water District must purchase monthly. On December 11, 2022, Mountain Water District adjusted its rates by \$0.08 per 1,000 gallons to reflect the increase in its cost of purchased water due to the increase in the City of Pikeville's rate for wholesale water service. On December 13, 2022, Mountain Water District applied to the Public Service Commission for approval of the rates set forth below.
