
**CERTIFICATE OF HEARING NOTICE**

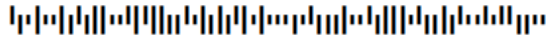
