MOTION TO SUBMIT CASE FOR ADJUDICATION
ON THE ADMINISTRATIVE RECORD

Comes now East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. (“EKPC”), by counsel, pursuant to the January 26, 2023 Order (“January 26th Order”) of the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) and other applicable law, and hereby moves the Commission to submit this case for a decision based upon the existing record and without the need for a hearing, respectfully stating as follows:

On December 21, 2022, EKPC filed a tariff to establish a residential electric vehicle (“EV”) off-peak charging pilot program to incentivize residential members to delay EV charging until off-peak hours. The January 26th Order opened an investigation to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff, suspended the effective date of the proposed tariff up to and including June 30, 2023 and established a procedural schedule. The procedural schedule allowed for a deadline for motions to intervene in the case, the filing of data requests, intervenor testimony, and rebuttal testimony. EKPC has provided all of the requested information and there have been no motions for intervention filed in this case. The January 26th Order provided a deadline of May 17, 2023 for EKPC to request a hearing or submit the case for a decision on the existing record.

EKPC believes that the issues presented in this case have been adequately addressed through the written discovery, that the administrative record is complete and that a formal evidentiary hearing is not necessary in this proceeding. EKPC respectfully moves to submit this case for an adjudication based upon the existing administrative record without a formal evidentiary hearing.

WHEREFORE, on the basis of the foregoing, EKPC respectfully moves the Commission to submit the case on the existing administrative record and without a formal evidentiary hearing.
