MOTION FOR EXTENSION

Comes now Atmos Energy Corporation (“Atmos Energy”), by counsel, and, hereby moves the Kentucky Public Service Commission (“Commission”) to grant Atmos Energy an eighteen-day extension to file its required report in the above-styled case, respectfully stating as follows:

On March 9, 2023, the Commission issued an Order authorizing Atmos Energy to implement a \$5,000,000,000 universal shelf registration for equity and debt financing. Ordering paragraph four of the Commission’s Order required Atmos Energy to file the certain information with the Commission within ten days of filing its 10Q or 10K filing with the SEC.


Atmos Energy filed its 10Q with the SEC on February 6, 2024, which would have made the report required in this proceeding due to be filed by February 16, 2024. However, the person that normally files the required report was out for several days with the flu, at the time the report was due. Upon her return, it was discovered the required report was not filed with the Commission.

Atmos Energy is filing the required report contemporaneously with this motion. Therefore, Atmos Energy is requesting an eighteen-day extension until March 5, 2024 to file the required report in this proceeding.

WHEREFORE, Atmos Energy requests an eighteen-day extension to file its required report in this proceeding.
